A BILL

BILL HISTORY

The bill is the product of UCSU leaders who have worked to establish CSA as a viable statewide institution. CSA has opened a state office in Denver and is currently engaged in organization building as well as legislative advocacy on financial aid and higher education funding. The referendum is to institutionalize CSA's funding under UCSU control.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill places the CSA funding question on the UCSU spring election ballot.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1:

The following question shall be placed on the ballot for the Spring 1991 UCSU election.

> "Do you support UCSU continue funding the Colorado Student Association (CSA), a statewide student organization advocating students' interests in higher education? A student fee of 50 cents per student, per semester, for the semesters that CSA is a member of the United States Student Association, USSA, for a period of two years would be assessed. The USSA is a national student organization in Washington, D.C. This represents a 12.5 cent increase in funding."
