BILL HISTORY

This bill is an attempt to address the level of cultural sensitivity of the UCSU Legislative Council. A low level of cultural sensitivity can impede good faith efforts to meet the needs of the students. It is essential for every member of the Legislative Council to increase his or her recognition and knowledge of every culture present on the CU Boulder campus.

According to our Constitution, "The University of Colorado Student Union shall not discriminate in hiring, firing, promotion, appointment, use of facilities, provision of services, funding or membership on the basis of religion, creed, race, ethnicity, nationality, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, age, physical handicap, or any other personal characteristic not directly related to the situation in question."

In order to better perform our duties as Legislative Council members in service to all the students of University of Colorado-Boulder and in keeping with our constitutional mandate against discrimination, we propose that once during every legislative council session, the Legislative Council will go through Cultural Awareness Training.

Bill Summary

This bill requires the UCSU Legislative Council members to go through a minimum of eight hours of Cultural Awareness Training once during every legislative council session, . MCCC is willing to offer workshops each session at times and dates to be decided each session.


BE IT ENACTED by the UCSU Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1:       The UCSU Legislative Council members will participate in a minimum of eight hours of Cultural Awareness Workshops during each


legislative council session at times and dates to be decided each session. These workshops will not take place during official Legislative Council sessions.
