A BILL

BILL HISTORY

The International and National Voluntary Service Training (INVST) program is a 17 credit, two-year program administered by the Conflict & Peace Studies Department at CU-Boulder. It trains students in ecological conservation, social justice, and non-violent ways of solving problems. INVST members must deal with such problems as the destruction of rainforests, the increasing gap between the wealthy and the poor, sustainable economic growth and development, and the list goes on. To deal with the above mentioned problems, students are taught skills in conflict resolution, leadership, organizational management, computer networking, natural resource conservation and intercultural and interpersonal relations.

This year the Campus Outreach Opportunity League (COOL) will be hosting a conference in New Orleans. Some issues that will be dealt with is recruiting and training volunteers, discussions on motivation for service, ethnicity and culture, gender, sexual orientation, religious affiliation, and more. The COOL Conference will give INVST students new perspectives and a networking system to deal with other problems.

BILL SUMMARY

To allocate \$750.00 from Central Reserve to cover the costs for 3 students to attend the COOL Conference in New Orleans, LA, on March 7-10, 1991.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$750.00 + GAR from Central Reserve toward costs for 3 students to attend the COOL Conference in New Orleans, LA on March 7-10, 1991.

SECTION 2: A written report will be submitted pursuant to 24ECB#4.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.


