A RESOLUTION

BILL HISTORY

Whereas: The United States of America, together with many other nations, is now fully engaged in military action in the Persian Gulf region, and;

Whereas: According to the University of Colorado Student Union's Constitution's preamble, the University of Colorado Student Union exists in large part "to provide the best possible excellence in education", and;

Whereas:

In a climate of stress and fear, students of all personal and political beliefs suffer in their ability to learn;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO STUDENT UNION, THAT:

SECTION 1:

The University of Colorado Student Union shall be committed to providing students with support services as needed to provide the university with a climate conducive to education.

SECTION 2:

UCSU shall work to provide student access to counseling services in order to assist students with particular concerns related to war, such as personal safety, fear of a future draft of civilians to active military duty, conscientious objector status and information, information on military service and concern for loved ones in the military.

SECTION 3:

UCSU shall work with university faculty to provide opportunities for students to discuss and debate war-related issues. UCSU shall promote an atmosphere of intelligent dialogue in which all sides of each issue may be rationally debated. UCSU endorses the faculty discussions planned for January 21, and any further discussions.

SECTION 4:

UCSU shall be attentive to the needs of any students who may be called to active military service, and work to ensure that they may finish their educations in due time upon completion of their military duties.

SECTION 5:

UCSU affirms the right of every student to express their voices through peaceful, non-violent demonstrations.

SECTION 6.

This resolution takes effect upon passage.
