A RESOLUTION

In order to increase student's understanding of the world's diversity and pluralism, current Arts & Sciences requirements mandate that incoming students take three credit hours of either gender and ethnic diversity, or non-western cultures courses. However, this either/or requirement is not sufficient to give students adequate exposure to ethnic, gender, and non-western issues. Therefore the sponsors of this bill want the Arts & Sciences requirement to mandate 3 credit hours of both ethnic and gender courses.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- 1: UCSU supports a change in Arts & Sciences requirements to include 3 hours of gender, and 3 hours of ethnic course
2. UCSU also supports a change in curricular options in gender and ethnic courses to courses that do not reflect a Euro-centric perspective.
3. This resolution takes effect upon passage.
