A BILL

The Student Chapter of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) is an organization for undergraduate students interested in Chemical Engineering. We provide information on graduate schools and bring in guest lecturers from industries. In addition AIChE sponsors social activities to encourage meeting other students as well as interaction with the faculty. The overall purpose of our chapter is to unite Chemical Engineering students and to introduce them to different aspects of the discipline.

The CU Student Chapter would like to send four officers to the National AIChE Conference. The National Conference is in Los Angeles, California the weekend of November 15-18, 1991.

The student program of the conference consists of a career fair, graduate school advising and leadership workshops. This will allow us to make personal contacts with industry leaders and graduate school recruiters. The chapter workshops will give us ideas to strengthen and improve our chapter.

AIChE has traditionally sent its officers to this conference and would like to continue this tradition with the help of CCS.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates \$496.00 + GAR from Council of Colleges and Schools account #1391200 to fund two airline tickets to the National AIChE Conference in Los Angeles, CA in November 15-18, 1991.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges & Schools of the University of Colorado, THAT:

- SECTION 1: This bill allocates \$496.00 + GAR from the Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200 to fund two airline tickets to the National AIChE Conference in Los Angeles, CA in November 15-18, 1991.
- SECTION 2: A written report shall be submitted pursuant 34CCSB#15.
- SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
