BILL HISTORY

Over the past several years, most, if not all, local schools finish each fiscal year with funds left over in their treasuries.

Jon Tsuda has requested that the Council of Colleges and Schools set a precedent and decide what to do with leftover funds. For example:

- a: divide it equally among each school
- b: divide a portion of it among each school
- c: have CCS spend it

BILL SUMMARY

This bill requires local schools to submit a "Petition of Return" in order to receive any or all remaining funds in their treasury. These petitions shall be examined by the Council of Colleges & Schools.

This policy takes effect beginning with monies left over from fiscal year 1990-1991.

BE IT ENACTED by the University of Colorado Council of Colleges & Schools, THAT:

SECTION 1:

This bill shall require each local school to file a "Petition of Return" with the Council of Colleges and Schools to be granted access to any or all remaining funds in their treasury from the prior fiscal year.

SECTION 2:

The "Petition of Return" must be filed with the Council of Colleges & Schools Vice-Chair no later than the 2nd scheduled Fall meeting of the Council.

SECTION 3:

The Council of Colleges & Schools shall review all "Petition's of Return" and determine how much, if any, shall be granted to each local school.

Monies left over after the "Petition" process SECTION 4:

shall be placed in a pool. A local school may then request additional funds. These funds are subject to Council of Colleges & Schools approval.

SECTION 5:

A "Petition of Return" Committee shall be formed to determine a criteria with which the Council of Colleges & Schools shall determine monies to be granted. The committee must bring a list of criteria to the Council of Colleges & Schools by

July 25, 1991 to be voted on for final approval.

SECTION 6: This bill takes effect upon passage.
