BILL HISTORY

The Midyear Regional Meetings of the Academy of Students of Pharmacy (ASP) are major programs sponsored by the American Pharmaceutical Association (APhA). The 1991 Midyear Regional Meeting (MRM) will be hosted by the School of Pharmacy, University of Colorado in Boulder, November 8-10, 1991. The students of ASP have been preparing this summer to be able to attend this regional meeting and have been actively involved in the responsibilities and preparations required of the host school.

The meetings consist of open discussions of important pharmacy issues, seminars, career planning, and most important, the finalization of policy proposals. The students are an important part of the policy making within the organization and cast a third of the vote in the house of delegates. Election of regional delegate, alternate delegate and MRM coordinator also takes place. The current region 8 delegate and MRM coordinator are from the School of Pharmacy, University of Colorado.

- SECTION 2: A written report shall be submitted pursuant 34CCSB#15.
