BILL HISTORY

The <u>Colorado Journal of International Environmental Law and Policy</u> is an interdisciplinary publication dedicated to the examination of environmental issues with international implications. It is run entirely by 2nd and 3rd year law students. The <u>Journal</u> publishes two issues a year, one in January and one in June. Work is currently underway on the Fall issue, which will focus on the International Watercourses Colloquium which will be held at the law school on October 18, 1991. International experts in the field of watercourse resources will be delivering papers at this colloquium, which will then be reprinted in the <u>Journal</u>.

The <u>Journal</u> would like to request funding to send one representative to the 1991 International Law Weekend in New York City, October 31 - November 2, 1991. This is an annual meeting attended by some of the top names in international law. There are approximately 10 different panel discussions on some of the leading issues in international law (see attached schedule).

It is through weekends such as the one in New York that we make contacts that allow us to host events like the Watercourses Colloquium. By attending the International Law Weekend we hope to accomplish three goals: solicit papers for our Spring issue, attract internationally recognized speakers of the CU campus, and gain recognition for CU, the Law School, and the <u>Journal</u>. For these reasons, this bill allocates \$494.00 + GAR from Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200 to pay air and travel expenses for one CJIELP representative to attend the 1991 International Law Weekend.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges & Schools of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT: 35 Council of Colleges & Schools Bill #7

SECTION 1: An amount of \$494.00 + GAR from the Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200 be allocated for the cost of air and travel expenses for one CJIELP to attend the 1991 International Law Weekend.

SECTION 2: A written report shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
