BILL HISTORY

The University of Colorado Student Chapter of the Illuminating Engineering Society has been an important aspect of lighting education at the university since it was founded in 1974. The student chapter is sponsored by the Rocky Mountain Chapter of the Illuminating Engineering Society in Denver.

The student chapter organizes a Professional Lighting retreat each semester. Begun in 1982, these three day retreats are extremely beneficial because they bring lighting designers and lighting engineers into extended contact with students. BILL SUMMARY
