BILL HISTORY

The Graduate Student Advisory Council (GSAC), in consultation with graduate student organizations at other universities, has gathered ideas on how to promote exchange of ideas between various groups within the university community. An event at American University that worked well to accomplish this goal was the Round Table Dinner. GSAC proposes a similar event at CU.

The structure of the Round Table Dinner is fairly simple. Six to eight tables are populated with people from some of the following constituencies: undergraduate, graduates, alumni, faculty, staff, administrators, community members and members of the media. In our setting, we would propose having a media representative at each table facilitate the discussion. Each table would discuss a different university-related topic, such as safety, the mission of the university, the role of athletics, health and child care, the undergraduate experience, diversity, the university-community relationship, and university-related ethics. At the end of the evening, each moderator would present a short summary of the discussion at his or her table.

After the Round Table Dinner, documents will be produced outlining the specific conversations at each table. These documents will be sent to all funding bodies, and made available to the media and interested individuals.

GSAC proposes to hold such a Round Table Dinner at 6 p.m. October 16, 1991 in the Aspen Room of the University Memorial Center.

BILL SUMMARY
