## BILL HISTORY

For the past three years, Onstage Student Theatre and Dance Group has received monies from a referendum in order to fund visiting guest artists, student projects and performances, and meetings to support the campus performing arts community. This referendum has become tremendously important in helping students enrich their cultural and artistic education. It has allowed Onstage to provide free or low cost performances and workshops to all CU Students.

Students have been able, through the Onstage referendum, to produce their own acting, directing, and dance projects with technical support. Onstage has purchased stage lighting and has been able to arrange theatre space for these projects. The guest artists the referendum has provided include Spalding Gray, Bob EEN (From Merideth Monk's Group), A Butoh Dance Workshop, African Bushwomen Dancers, Martin Jenkins from the BBC, and a director from the Moscow Art Theatre, among others. All workshops and presentations have been very well attended by students of many disciplines.

The referendum consists of 25 cents per UCB student per semester. In the past this has come to equal approximately \$10,000 for the referendum account. In 1991, this referendum will require reapproval. Onstage requests the Legislative Council to place this referendum question on the Fall 1991 UCSU Election Ballot.

## BILL SUMMARY

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: The UCSU Legislative Council shall place a referendum question on the Fall 1991 Election Ballots:

Will you continue to give 35 cents per sengler

for the next three years in support of the Nationally

The question shall read:
