BILL HISTORY

In 1989 the University of Vermont and Middelbury College adopted a program entitled CUPPS (Cannot Use Paper, Plastic or Styrofoam). The program was a huge success. The Resource Management Commission decided that this university would be an appropriate place to facilitate its growth. The program is a waste reduction effort. It entails the production of a twenty two oz. thermal mug, with a no spill lid. Because of the way we have planned our funding, every incoming student will receive a mug for free, as well as an entire recycling package. This will be initiated in August and will hopefully repeat itself every year. We have found that continuance of the program is possible because off-campus residents and any other on campus residents will be able to purchase the mug for approximately \$2. The cost is only implemented to make this program generate its own funding. Restaurants surrounding the campus will be presented with a contract of participation. They may simply honor the mug in their establishment or offer a discount. The research and solicitation of outside sponsors for the program has been going on since September 1989. The commission felt that without the support of the student body leaders the program would not get off the ground. We are planning to go to other university sources.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates remaining funds of Legislative Council of FY 90-91+GAR (approximately \$1,628 + GAR) in order to help pay for mugs for the new incoming residents and an overflow for off-campus residents.

BE IT ENACTED by the University of Colorado Legislative Council THAT:

SECTION 1: This bill allocates remaining funds of Legislative Council of FY 90-91 + GAR (approximately \$1,628 + GAR) to help fund the CUPPS program.


SECTION 2: A written report will be submitted pursuant 24ECB#4.
