## BILL HISTORY

The first International Conference on Sexual Assault on Campus will be held October 2-5, 1991 in Orlando, FL. The conference will involve a wide spectrum of highly notable speakers from many different universities and health services. Key topics will be addressed, such as orientation for campus women; consciousraising for campus men; security, post-traumatic counseling and recovering; administration responsibilities; cooperation with community and human service agencies and larger, society-wide issues.
