BILL HISTORY

During the April 1991 elections UCSU became a member of the United States Student Association (USSA) by virtue of the student vote to become members of the Colorado Student Association. Accordingly, UCSU sent a delegation of eight to USSA's National Congress, held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, August 12-18. At the Congress, Shana Morrow was elected to the National Board of Directors as a Regional Director for the Rocky Mountain Region.

The Board of Directors meets five times during the year between National Congresses, to set priorities for action and direct the nation's largest student organization. As one of Colorado's members of the Board, Shana provides a voice for the students of our region, our state, and CU-Boulder in determining the course of USSA and the work done on education issues in the nation's Capitol.

The first Board of Director's meeting will be held October 25-28 in Washington, D.C. at the national office in USSA. Attending this meeting will give Shana the opportunity to voice Colorado's unique concerns to the national board, as well as give her the chance to gather more information about USSA and determine how it can best benefit UCSU. Shana will be paying for her own ground transportation, meals as well as lodging. Shana requests that Representative Council provide her airfare of \$230 + GAR.

BILL SUMMARY
