BILL HISTORY

Alpha Phi Omega is a national co-ed service organization, dedicated to furthering the principles of community service, leadership, and friendship. The group is devoted to sponsoring philanthropic activities on campus, but they also direct their efforts to bettering the surrounding community and nation. The APO Chapter at CU currently has 50+ members, and is one of the most active groups on campus.

In the past, APO has exemplified the best aspects that the University of Colorado has to offer. The number of events that APO has put on in the past couple of years is truly extensive.

Just to list a few:

- Blood Drives on campus for the past few years
- Picnics with children waiting for Big Brothers
- Taking Head Start kids on trips to the zoo
- Helping during bill/schedule pick up
- Painting and repairing the Boulder County Safe House
- Professor's Night Out

APO is currently planning an event called "Spirit Bike Ride." The event is designed to show the people of our community and state, as well as those in Oklahoma, just how much school and team spirit the students at CU have. APO members plan to ride bicycles, in relay-style, from Folsom Stadium to Norman, Oklahoma (a distance of approximately 700 miles). The trip will begin on October 16, and end on October 19, when CU plays Oklahoma in Norman. In organizing this event, APO will raise \$1,000.00 for the American Heart Association through corporate donations and public sponsors. This will not only be a great way in which we, as students, can help donate to charity, but it will also provide an excellent opportunity to funnel our school spirit and support of our team into a project and benefit our community.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates \$715.00 + GAR to fund Alpha Phi Omega's "Spirit Bike Ride" to Norman, Oklahoma from October 16-19, 1991.

BE IT ENACTED by the Representative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$715.00 + GAR shall be awarded to Alpha Phi Omega to help pay the costs incurred by the Spirit Bike Ride.


SECTION 2: This bill takes effect upon passage.
