BILL HISTORY

The 1st Annual Chicano Theme Writing Contest has been started by the students of Metropolitan State College, University of Colorado at Denver, and University of Colorado-Boulder, to encourage writers in their work.

All students are welcome to enter. The only requirement is that the theme pertain to the Chicano community. Students may write an essay or poem from a research paper, a personal experience, a historical paper or a commentary representing their views. This contest will increase the prestige of Chicano literature, which is tremendously misrepresented.

Writers will not only gain recognition but will have an opportunity to win a prize. There are awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in non-fiction, fiction and poetry categories.






