BILL HISTORY

The Business Law Association is a student organization which sponsors speakers, discussions, and events focusing on trends and developments in the area business law, potential areas of practice, and course selection planning. Our goal is to provide our members with the best information and connections to be successful in the area of business law.

Arbitration is one of the fastest growing areas of the law. Simply put, it provides an alternative forum for parties who have agreed in advance to "arbitrate" rather than go through the formal and extremely clogged court system. A neutral third party lawyer, who has expertise in the specific area (labor, insurance, construction, etc.) hears the case and enters a judgment.

In the area of labor arbitration, employees like it because it is much quicker and less expensive than going through the formal court system. Business likes it for the same reasons. With today's cost of litigation, even if they are never found liable for anything, a business could face bankruptcy just in defending claims against it. Arbitration is, therefore, one of the most universally accepted and expanding areas of the law.

The keynote speaker is the national president of the American Arbitration Association. In addition, there will be many seminars on various specific issues.
