A BILL

BILL HISTORY

The student society of the American Society of Civil Engineers is a strong group of dedicated people with interests in Civil Engineering. The society provides a means for students to develop the principles of engineering taught in the classroom at a hands on, practical level. The application of concepts taught in the classroom is vital in the students development as a professional engineer. ASCE helps to provide these experiences through various activities.

Every year all universities in the Rocky Mountain Region gather for a conference. This conference provides students with the opportunity to develop in relation to other universities and to gain practical experience. This year the conference is to be held at the University of Wyoming, April 3 & 4. The objectives of this year's conference are to provide a forum for the design and construction of civil engineering-related projects. Hands on design experience will be possible through the steel bridge, and concrete canoe competitions. ASCE will return with strengthened ties to peer universities and with practical experience to share at C.U.

Attendance for 30 students is necessary to ensure proper representation and is the reason for this bill. ASCE has solicited additional funding but not enough to cover costs.

Because of competition with other university events, ASCE must reserve motor pool vehicles as soon as possible.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill will allocate an amount not to exceed \$750.00 + GAR from Council of Colleges and Schools account #1391200 for transportation and partial conference fees for students attending the ASCE conference April 3 & 4 at the University of Wyoming.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges & Schools of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: This bill allocates \$750.00 + GAR from the Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200 for funding of transportation and partial funding of conference fees for students attending the ASCE conference


