A BILL

BILL HISTORY

The Student Board of the College of Business acts as the liaison between the students and faculty of the College. The Board provides funding to student organizations, and works on projects to benefit the maximum number of students possible. Acting on a large
5 interest of the student body, the Board is currently working to bring 30 coin operated lockers to the College of Business. The lockers would benefit the student body on a daily basis. Some situations include: students preparing for interview need the service of lockers for storing clothing, books, etc. Many students
10 stay at the business school all day between classes, studying group meetings, club meetings and need a place to store books and other belongings.

BILL SUMMARY

15 This bill allocates \$2,973.21 + GAR from Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200-local schools rollover fund-for the purchase of 30 coin operated lockers to be located in the College of Business. Profits from continued use of lockers should be
20 retained from year to year for maintenance of lockers with the option to purchase more.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges & Schools of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

25 SECTION 1: This bill allocates \$2,973.21 + GAR from the Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200-local schools rollover fund - for the purchase of 30 coin operated lockers to be located in the College of
30 Business. Profits from the continuing use of lockers should be retained from year to year for maintenance of lockers with the option to purchase more.

35 SECTION 2: A written report shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.


