BILL HISTORY

5 The University of Colorado Model United Nations (CUMUN) is an organization committed to the sponsorship and coordination of student participation in model United Nations conferences with the aim of increasing student understanding of foreign-policy making process and the role of domestic and international organizations in that process.

10 One of the more prestigious and challenging events of its kind is the Harvard National Model United Nations (HNMUN). The philosophy of HNMUN is that simulating sessions of the United Nations promotes better understanding and insight of the powers and limits of such powers within multilateral diplomacy. HNMUN's committee structure, agenda, and procedures are chosen to reflect reality as closely as possible.

15 CUMUN has opted to participate in the annual HNMUN this year. The University of Colorado's delegation of 20 students has been selected to represent the Netherlands, from February 19-23 at the Boston Sheraton Hotel.

20 Delegates are expected to familiarize themselves with the domestic situation of the country assigned, its international relationships, its positions on the issues the committee will discuss, and UN procedures. Last year the CU Delegation did exceedingly well, returning with awards for outstanding representation of the assigned nation.

BILL SUMMARY

30 This bill allocates an amount not to exceed \$1,290.00+GAR from the Council of Colleges and Schools account #1391200 to defray the costs of hotel. Additional costs will be funded through CUMUN fundraising, Arts & Sciences Student Government, etc., the balance will be the responsibility of the student delegates.

35 BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges and Schools of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

40 SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$1,200.00+GAR be allocated from the Council of Colleges & Schools account #1391200 to the CUMUN to defray the cost of hotel for HNMUN.
