A BILL

BILL HISTORY

5 The Academy of Students of Pharmacy (ASP) is a division of the
American Pharmaceutical Association (APhA). Each year at the
national APhA Meeting, ASP holds special meetings and activities
for its members. One of the activities is the National Patient
10 Counseling Competition at which one student from each of the
schools of pharmacy competes for national title. Last year our
school placed in the top ten in the nation and again this year we
will be sending a school representative to the competition. The
School of Pharmacy, University of Colorado, is also one of three
15 pharmacy schools to receive an award for most increase in
membership over the previous year and one of our members will
receive one of four national awards for outstanding student
leadership. A member of our local chapter is to be part of the
Reference Committee, involved in the development of resolutions
proposed by the student chapters and voted on by those students
attending the national meeting. The students of APhA-ASP are an
important part of the policy making within the organization and
cast a third of the votes in the house of delegates. We also have
20 a student attending the meeting who is part of the national task
force assigned to help formulate a curriculum for the new proposed
Pharm. D. program. This task force will be presenting its findings
to the students during the national meeting. The activities and
meetings are numerous and we plan on sending several ASP members to
cover all the activities and meetings that will take place. The
25 APhA annual meeting will be held in San Diego, CA, between March 13
to 17, 1992.1 The students of the ASP chapter in Boulder have been
active in fund raising projects to help with expenses for the
meeting.


