BILL HISTORY

With the sudden increased awareness of gay and lesbian issues on the Boulder Campus, this is the ideal time to provide the university community with in-depth information of the longstanding, openly discriminating policy of the Reserve Officer's Training Corps.

Two students, Robert Schwitz, St. Louis, MO and Robert Bettiker, Cambridge, MA, who were expelled from ROTC because of their sexual orientation, have agreed to come to CU-Boulder to discuss the Department of Defense ban on homosexuals as it affects the ROTC program and the university. This will not be a debate but rather a discussion to provide increased awareness and knowledge and an opportunity to hear both sides of a timely issue.

Executive staff members are in the process of contacting local Department of Defense officials and other members of government to provide a broader perspective. Together, the speakers will participate in a forum and question and answer session on campus on April 6, 1992.
