A RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION HISTORY

Whereas: On 27 November 1991, the University of Colorado Board of Regents announced that an informational panel discussion would take place at their 19 December meeting to discuss the inclusion of "sexual orientation" in the anti-discrimination clause of the Laws of the Regents; and

WHEREAS: The student representational bodies of the other three CU campuses have or are in the process of drafting strongly supporting such inclusion; and

WHEREAS: The University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council passed a strongly-worded measure, 34LCB#1, in support 15 November 1990; and

WHEREAS: The University of Colorado Student Union votes 3504-304 to include "sexual orientation" in its own documents, by adding Article XVIII to its Constitution in April 1990;

BE IT RESOLVED by the University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council, THAT:

SECTION 1: The University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council reaffirms all provisions of 34LCB#1.

SECTION 2: The University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council condemns any discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation

SECTION 3: The University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council maintains a continual commitment to this issue.

SECTION 4: This resolution takes effect upon passage.
