A BILL

BILL HISTORY

All current bills include a section requiring that all students who receive funding from UCSU Legislative Council must submit a written report "pursuant to 24ECB#4." This bill was originally passed on November 14, 1985.

26 ECB#21 was passed on February 5, 1987. It stated:

"In the past, Council has sponsored many students to attend educational conferences and workshops. While most participants promise to reach out to the student body and share their experiences, very rarely do we see results. Council has recently amended many such bill to include (sic) a section requiring the writing of an editorial by the participant. This legislation will formalize this requirement and make the editorial mandatory."

Over time, the mandate of 26ECB#21 has fallen by the wayside while 24ECB#4 has continued as our standard. These bill were passed 5 and 7 years ago, respectively, which make it necessary that these "laws" be reviewed and updated.

BILL SUMMARY

All students and/or student groups who receive funding from UCSU Legislative Council and Representative Council are required to submit a written report to the President Pro-Tempore and submit editorials to all campus newspapers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

All students and/or student groups who receive funding from UCSU Legislative Council and the Representative Council are required to submit a written report to the President Pro-Tempore.

45 50	SECTION 2:	The report shall include the following: 1) general overview of the event(s) and the phase(s) of that event, 2) attendance of all phases of the event(s), 3) did the group sponsoring the event feel they accomplished their goals set forth prior to the event, as listed in the Bill History, 4) a detailed account of expenditures.
55	SECTION 3:	All students and/or student groups who receive special event funding from UCSU Legislative Council and Representative Council shall write and submit editorials to all the campus newspapers.
60	SECTION 4:	This report and editorials shall be submitted within 30 days of the end of the event. Failure to do so may jeopardize future funding from UCSU Legislative Council and Representative Council.
65	SECTION 5:	Legislative Council and Representative Council bills shall include a section stating "A written report and editorials shall be submitted pursuant to 36LCB#20."
70	SECTION 6.	Sponsors are required to present the student(s) associated with the bill a copy of 36LCB#20.
70	SECTION 7.	With the passage of 36LCB#20, 26ECB#21 and 24ECB#4 will be superceded.
75	SECTION 8.	This bill shall take effect upon passage.
