A BILL

BILL HISTORY

A Custodial Staff of any institution must be considered the back bone of that institution. Often times a Custodial Staff is not thanked or considered or welcomed, **"in general, not appreciated"**, and it is high time that the University of Colorado Student Union re-evaluate its attitude toward the Custodial Staff, the back bone of its three buildings.

The Custodial Staff of the University Memorial Center, the Recreation Center, and the Wardenburg Student Health Center work daily in order to make these bids presentable to the public which uses our facilities. When the public views our buildings as clean and presentable, and in general a positive physical environment, they are more inclined to use the buildings.

While Legislative Council should appreciate the efforts of the Custodial Staff in all three buildings, the UMC Custodial Staff is most directly affected by the Council. Often, the Legislative Council leaves unacceptable messes at very late hours for the already busy staff to clean up. The governing body of the Union must recognize the importance of good relations with the Custodial Staff. It is imperative therefore that Legislative Council host some form of appreciation reception for the UMC Custodial Staff.

Various members of the UMC Custodial Staff rarely have time where they would be able to get together for such an event, therefore, in conjunction with the reception, Legislative Council should study the possibility of granting the Custodians a paid hour off to attend the reception.

SECTION 1: This bill shall allocate \$320.00 + GAR from Central Reserve account #1391120 in order to fund an appreciation reception for the UMC Custodial Staff.

SECTION 2: In addition to the UMC Custodial Staff, the UCSU shall pay for the UCSU Executives, Legislative Council President Pro Tempore, Legislative Council Vice President Pro Tempore, Council of Colleges and Schools Chair, Representative Council Chair, and University Memorial Center Board Chair to attend the reception in order to show full UCSU support for the Custodial Staff.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.




