BILL HISTORY

The Equity and Excellence Award is an award for ethnic plurality (minority) faculty, staff and students. The award recognizes people who exemplify the commitment to equity and excellence in higher education through his or her work. The recipients of this award should demonstrate service to both the university and ethnic plurality communities, as well as outstanding academic achievement. These awards are given to two undergraduate students, two graduate students, one faculty member and one staff member. These recipients will receive a framed certificate and \$200.00.

This award will be given at the Equity and Excellence Banquet. This year marks the seventh year of the banquet. In addition to honoring the recipients, this year the ceremony will also recognize the graduating ethnic plurality students. The graduates will include those who received their degrees in December and those receiving their degrees in May.

UCSU's contribution to this event would be to provide invitations to the banquet for the graduating ethnic plurality students. This contribution would exhibit the support and commitment that the University of Colorado Student Union has to diversity.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates an amount not to exceed \$488.96 + GAR from Legislative Council account #1391120 for the Equity and Excellence Awards Banquet and Graduation Ceremony on April 15, 1992 in the UMC Ballroom.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:
