A BILL

BILL HISTORY

Considering the events of the past couple of weeks in the Legislative Council Meetings, there is a need to restructure the process in which the Legislative Council is able to effectively hear Health Insurance Waiver Appeals. Several members of Council have considered alternative means of resolving this waiver appeal process.

After discussion of the topic, two measures seem to be necessary. First there is a need for concrete guidelines for appeals of the Wardenburg Health Insurance Waiver. Second, there needs to be an arm of the Legislative Council that addresses these appeals. It is apparent that the current Student Fee Waiver Appeal Committee would be that arm.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill directs the Legislative Council to empower the Student Fee Waiver Appeal Committee to hear the Health Insurance Waiver Appeals.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT;

Section 1: The Legislative Council shall empower the Student Fee Waiver Appeal Committee to hear the Health Insurance Waiver Appeals, as the representative of the Legislative Council, in the final appeal process.

Section 2: The Student Fee Waiver Appeal Committee shall work in conjunction with the Student Health Board in order to formulate a concrete set of criteria to be followed during the appeal process.

Section 3: This bill shall take effect upon passage.




