BILL HISTORY

Article XIII.B. states:

"B. Procedures

1. Parties that wish to be granted "exception status" to regular Joint Board policy must initially appeal to the Joint Board for consideration of the matter. They may not circumvent the appropriate Joint Board.
2. If, in case of their request is denied, the party may then, as a last resort, appeal to the Legislative Council for final reconsideration.
3. The Joint Board will inform the petitioner of this appeal."

To create a standing Legislative Council policy in order to uphold this By-Law as it pertains to Wardenbrug Health Insurance Waiver Appeals, permanent measures need to be taken. It has been proposed that the Student Fee Waiver Committee be expanded to hear these appeals in the place of the entire Legislative Council.

Considering the expanded responsibilities of the committee it should be incorporated into the By-Laws as a standing committee. This action would create a permanent solution to the Insurance Waiver Appeals problems now facing the council.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill creates a standing committee, which will be responsible for hearing the waiving of any and all appealable UCSU fees. This includes, but is not limited to Mandatory Student Fees and Wardenburg Health Insurance Waivers.

UCSU By-Laws shall be changed in accordance with the passage of 36 Legislative Council Bill #6.

36 Legislative Council Bill #6 - page 2

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT;

**Section 1:** The UCSU Legislative Council shall establish and maintain a standing Committee for the purpose of hearing the final appeals of all appealable UCSU fees. This includes, but is not limited to Mandatory Student Fees and Wardenburg Health Insurance Waivers.

**Section 2:** Article VI, Part B., Section 1 of the UCSU by-laws (Committees) shall read:

The Legislative Council shall establish and maintain an Appointments Committee, a Rules Committee, an Elections Committee, a Student Organizations Committee, an Outreach Committee, a Committee for Diversity, and a Fee Waiver Committee.

**Section 3:** Article VI, Part B., Section 9 shall be added to the UCSU by-laws to read:

**9. Fee Waiver Committee**


- a. The Fee Waiver Committee shall consist of six (6) members; Three Council of College and Schools Members, and Three Representatives at Large to be chosen from and elected by the Legislative Council.
- b. The Fee Waiver Committee shall have the final decision in the appeal of all appealable UCSU fees.
- c. The current Student Fee Waiver ad-hoc committee will be disbanded. The responsibilities of this committee will be transferred to the newly established standing Fee Waiver Committee.
- d. The current chairs of the ad-hoc committee, Edward J. Batchelor and Joseph N. Russo shall become the chairs of the newly created standing committee.
- e. Sections C through E shall be eliminated from the by-laws at the end of Session 36.

**Section 4:** This bill will take effect upon passage.


