## BILL HISTORY

The International and National Voluntary Service Training (INVST) program is a 17 credit two-year program administered by the Conflict and Peace Studies Department. The purpose of the program is to teach students to become effective agents for social change. Students learn skills such as leadership, conflict resolution, computer networking and small group dynamics. They also make a commitment to service work during school and after graduation.
