BILL HISTORY

5 The International and National Voluntary Service Training (INVST) program is a 17 credit two-year program administered by the Conflict and Peace Studies Department. The purpose of the program is to teach students to become effective agents for social change. Students learn skills such as leadership, conflict resolution, computer networking and small group dynamics. They also make a commitment to service work during school and after graduation.

10 This year the Campus Outreach Opportunity League (COOL) will be hosting a conference in Orlando, Fl. Some issues that the conference will address are: recruiting and training volunteers, motivations for service, ethnicity and culture. The COOL Conference will give INVST students new perspectives on service work and chance to network with students from
15 around the nation.

BILL SUMMARY

20 To allocate \$1050.00 + GAR from Central Reserve account #1391120 to cover the costs for 3 students to attend the COOL Conference in Orlando, Fl in February 1992.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

25 SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$750.00 + GAR from Central Reserve account #1391120 toward the costs for three (3) to attend the COOL Conference in Orlando, Fl in February 1992.

30 SECTION 2: A written report will be submitted pursuant to 24ECB#4.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.




