BILL HISTORY

Oxfam America is an international agency that funds self-help development projects and disaster relief in poor countries in Africa, Asia, and Latin America, and also prepares and distributes educational material for people in the United States on the issues of development and hunger. The student run Oxfam Hunger Action at the CU-Boulder campus works on community projects, gleaning, the Fast for a World Harvest, Overseas Development projects such as Bike-Aid, and community and campus educational outreach.

Overseas Development Network chapter members from all over the United States will come together to build their skills as chapter organizers and student leaders.
