## A BILL

## BILL HISTORY

The American Bar Association is the largest professional organization in the country. It is best known for its huge annual convention. This year's speakers included retired Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall, Anita Hill, and Hillary Clinton.

The ABA is divided up into a number of divisions, most of which correspond to the type of law practiced by the lawyers who belong to that division (tax, labor, civil rights, etc.). Another of the major divisions of the ABA is the Law Student Division. The Law Student Division has over 100,000 members from virtually every law school in the nation - plus several thousand pre-law students from dozens of undergraduate institutions.

The Law Student Division provides many invaluable services for its members - from life insurance to funding for LSAT and bar preparation courses. The most important function of the Law Student Division, however, is its drafting and support of ABA legislation which has a direct impact on how accredited law schools will be operated (which includes everything from the monitoring of the quality of libraries to admissions policies to the amount and manner of distribution of financial aid).

As might be expected, the Law Student Division is further divided into regions. It is within these regions that most of the "real" work is done. The regional conference will be held in Las Vegas on October 2-4, 1992. This conference is the big annual meeting of the region. The following universities will be represented:
