BILL HISTORY The Illuminating Engineering Society student chapter is a branch of the professional organization. The student chapter sponsors 2 activities for engineering students interested in the field of lighting engineering. A Wednesday evening lecture series brings in 4 professionals from the lighting industry to help students understand what the lighting field is all about. Every fall the 6 IES sponsors a retreat for its members and three professionals.
