BILL HISTORY

The Illuminating Engineering Society student chapter is a branch of the professional organization. The student chapter sponsors activities for engineering students interested in the field of lighting engineering. A Wednesday evening lecture series brings in professionals from the lighting industry to help students understand what the lighting field is all about. Every fall the IES sponsors a retreat for its members and three professionals. Students and their guests are sequestered in the mountains for a weekend of workshops and discussion about their chosen careers. This year the retreat is scheduled for November 13-15, 1992.

The student chapter of the IES also serves the College of Engineering by helping with open houses and other various activities. Tutoring is also offered by the senior students for first semester lighting students.
