BILL HISTORY

2 The Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers (SHPE) Student
3 Chapter at UC Boulder is an organization that promotes and supports
4 engineering and science education. We act as a support group for
5 over 40 engineering students and regularly tutor students at the
6 junior high and high school level. We also concentrate on
7 developing our members so that they can enter the corporate world
8 effectively. SHPE adds to the diversity of our campus and helps to
9 ensure that students interested in engineering and science will
10 make it to college and make it through college.

11 The UC Boulder SHPE chapter will be attending a regional meeting
12 over the weekend of October 9-11, 1992 in Albuquerque, New Mexico.
13 SHPE chapter representatives from Utah, Colorado, Kansas and New
14 Mexico will be meeting to discuss regional business and to plan the
15 Region III Leadership Conference held at the end of the school
16 year. This meeting is crucial in maintaining communications with
17 other SHPE chapters in our region and in planning a successful
18 leadership conference. The meeting also offers our chapter a
19 resource of new ideas for community projects, fund-raisers and
20 membership development. Over the October 9-11 weekend, the Region
21 III "Academic Olympics" will also be held. These Olympics act as
22 a play off between students in our region. The regional winners
23 will continue on to the national "Academic Olympics" that will be
24 held at the SHPE National Career Conference in February. The
25 "Academic Olympics" are a test of students' knowledge in
26 engineering and current events. Overall, the weekend promises to
27 be extremely beneficial to our chapter.

28 SHPE has decided to take 3 of our members to this event. To reduce
29 our costs to attend the event, we plan on renting vans and
30 carpooling with students from other SHPE Chapters in Colorado. We
31 have also asked for assistance in meals and lodging from the SHPE
32 Chapter in Albuquerque, and they have decided to cover most of
33 these costs. Therefore, we request that CCS help to pay for our
34 transportation costs to the event.

BILL SUMMARY

35 This bill allocates \$160.00 plus GAR from the Council of Colleges
36 and Schools account #1390200 to help cover transportation expenses
37 for three SHPE student members to attend the Region III Meeting and
38 Academic Olympics in Albuquerque, New Mexico on October 9-11, 1992.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges and Schools of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: This bill allocates \$160.00 plus GAR from the Council of Colleges and Schools account #1390200 to help cover transportation expenses for three SHPE student members to attend the Region III Meeting and Academic Olympics in Albuquerque, New Mexico on October 9-11, 1992.

SECTION 2: A written report shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
