BILL HISTORY

2 The UCSU Legislative Council and the Tri-Executives consist of
approximately 26 bright, hardworking, motivated student leaders.
4 These leaders are elected by the student body in which they serve.
A big assumption present is that these 26 individuals with varying
6 personalized talents and skills will come together at the start of
the semester and form a cohesive, strong, mission-oriented group.
As past experience and research show, this group mentality does not
8 form instantaneously without any focused effort at cohesion.

10 It is not uncommon for many large governing bodies and corporations
to provide money, time, and space for group cohesion/team building.
12 Team building is an organized effort to improve group
effectiveness. It involves the actualization of such concepts as
personal commitment, trust, openness, support, safety and
16 individuality. It precipitates group allowance of conflicts of
ideas and growth throughout. Team building is moving from a
collection of individuals with talents and drives to a solid,
18 powerful, mission-oriented, interdependent team. The sum of the
whole is greater than the sum of its parts.

20 As a newly elected member of the Legislative Council, I propose a
team building retreat for two reasons. One is to provide a get
22 away spaced where we can be free of daily distractions and
concerns, to just simply get to know each other as individuals.
24 The second reason is to facilitate group introspection, to look at
how we work as a group, in a group, etc. A member of the
26 consultation team at MCCCDC is assisting in the planning of various
group experiences for the retreat.

30 The retreat is scheduled for a date in September, 1992, to be
determined by the availability of a majority of Legislative Council
32 members and Executives, at CU's Mountain Research Center outside of
Nederland. The cost is minimal, yet with effort and open-
34 mindedness of each member in Legislative Council and the Tri-
Executives, this cost will far be repaid in overall group cohesion
36 and development, yielding a more strongly focused governmentation
and increased efficiency in our roles as student leaders.

BILL SUMMARY

To allocate an amount not to exceed \$405.64 (this includes a \$100.00 refundable deposit) + GAR from Legislative Council account #1391120 to the Legislative Council and Tri-Executives Fall Semester Team Building Retreat scheduled for a date in September, 1992, to be determined by the availability of a majority of Legislative Council members and Executives.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: \$405.64 (including a \$100.00 refundable deposit) + GAR be allocated from Legislative Council account #1391120 to cover lodging, meals and supplies.

SECTION 2: A written report and editorials must be submitted pursuant 36LCB#20.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.




