## A BILL

## BILL HISTORY

The State of Colorado has seen trends of decreased funding for higher education as well as public schools for the past several years. Currently, the State of Colorado ranks 48 of 50 in per capita financial support of higher education. According to University of Colorado President Judith Albino, it ranks "49 on some scales, but they use the 48 number."

How has this decreased funding affected students? The University of Colorado has suffered numerous budget cuts in mid-fiscal year, lengthy hiring freezes, and decreased annual budgets. As students of the University of Colorado, we have seen faculty positions remain empty, library supplies not purchased, and regular tuition increases. We regularly put the blame for higher tuition on the Board of Regents, but with little state assistance, there is no other way to raise the needed funds to run the University.

As a "STUDENT UNION", we must remember to fight for the rights of students. We must convince members of the State Governments that in order for public education to go un-wasted, there must be affordable higher education. Therefore I request the month of September to be declared "FINANCIAL SUPPORT OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN COLORADO MONTH". To emphasize this, I have invited several state leaders to the Legislative Council to discuss this vital issue. On the list of invited speakers are: Governor Roy Romer; Ms. Karen Reinertson, Director of the Office of State Planning and Budgeting; Senator Ted Strickland, President of the Senate of the State of Colorado; Representative Chuck Berry, Speaker of the House of Representatives of the State of Colorado; and Representative Tony Grampsas, Chair of the State Joint Budget Committee.
