12		poor responsibility and accountability to past decisions. Approximately past pages of legislation and agendas exist from previous sessions.
16 18	WHEREAS:	A modernization of legislation management will provide better service to the student body. It will also increase accessibility and thus interest in UCSU issues.
20 22	WHEREAS:	Four students in Information Systems 4660, Joe DePaemelaere, Chris Brown, Terri Fellers and Samantha Phouthavong, have completed a 2 semester project of
24 26		analyzing and improving the UCSU method of storing past legislation. They previously presented their findings to the Legislative Council on February 27, 1992, at which time the Council applauded their work and encouraged the
28		development of a plan to implement. The Information Systems (IS) team has now completed a proposed computer system plan to upgrade UCSU's document storage.
