RESOLUTION HISTORY

Whereas: It is the obligation of the University of Colorado Student Union to represent and fight for the rights and interests of the students of the University of Colorado; and

Whereas: A substantial decrease in state funding to the University of Colorado would negatively impact the quality of education students receive; and

Whereas: A substantial decrease in state funding to the University of Colorado would do nothing to alleviate the problem of insufficient financial aid; and

Whereas: The passage of Amendment #1 would decrease state funding to higher education by at least \$50 million by the year 2000;


BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: The University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council strongly opposes the proposed Amendment #1.


SECTION 2: This resolution takes effect upon passage.
