BILL HISTORY

2 The University of Colorado Recycling Program requests assistance  
4 from UCSU Representatives Council for a multi-cultural recycling  
6 program to compliment C.U.'s diversity efforts. The project seeks  
8 to accommodate ethnically diverse members of the University of  
Colorado into our program. We hope to enhance diversity on campus  
by translating our procedural materials into 6 languages and  
through the creation of cooperative relationships with student  
cultural groups.

10 C.U. Recycling has always been interested in accommodating ethnic  
12 people into our program. The multi-cultural project was formed in  
1987 with a multi-lingual campaign. C.U. Recycling created posters  
with "Learn to Recycle" written in 6 different languages. Since  
that initial project, C.U. Recycling has worked with the Dennis  
Small Third World Center to coordinate question and answer  
sessions, cooperative working relations have been growing between  
C.U. Recycling and ethnic custodial workers, and translated fliers  
have been distributed at summer conferences at which foreign  
visitors were attending.

20 The multi-cultural project has historically been outside project  
22 for the C.U. Recycling Office. We would like to increase the  
importance of the campaign and include it into the job description  
of the promotions manager. This person will coordinate working  
relations among C.U. Recycling and ethnic student groups, crete  
translated procedural signs and brochures for Family Housing and  
other parts of campus, and coordinate the translation of a  
procedural slide show in the upcoming fiscal year.

28 C.U. Recycling has written a grant proposal in order to raise funds  
30 for the multi-cultural campaign. Our office has sought funds from  
the Academic Services Diversity Initiative, and we plan to submit  
funding proposals to Chancellor Corbridge, President Albino, and  
other departments on campus as directed by the Student Advisor to  
the Vice Chancellor.

BILL SUMMARY

36 To allocate an amount not to exceed \$530 + GAR from the  
38 Representative Council account #1391121 to cover 20% of the total  
cost (\$2655) of the projected cost of C.U. Recycling's Multi-  
cultural Campaign.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: \$530 + GAR to be allocated from the Representative Council account #1391121 to cover 20% of the total cost (\$2655) of the projected cost of C.U. Recycling's Multi-cultural Campaign.

SECTION 2: A written report and editorials will be submitted pursuant 36LCB#20.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.

Note:

1. C.U. Recycling proposes to cover 50% of personnel expense as "in kind": In addition student staff have work-study/financial aid. Combined, the in-kind expenses and work-study awards save over \$2000 that would normally be required.
