BILL HISTORY

The United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED), or Earth Summit was held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil on June 4-12 of this year. During the Earth Summit, world leaders made decisions on such issues as global warming, deforestation, and student interest in the conference showing that there is a need for some sort of closing remarks from people who were actual delegates or attendees to the Earth Summit. This bill would allocate funding for a UNCED forum to be held July 13 on the CU Boulder campus. It would enable people from different areas of the country to be able to come to the University of Colorado and speak on their experiences in Rio and their opinion of how the Earth Summit went.

BILL SUMMARY

To allocate an amount not to exceed \$700.00 + GAR from Representative Council account #1391121 to aid in the expenses incurred by the UNCED forum.

BE IT ENACTED by the Representative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**


SECTION 1: To allocate an amount not to exceed \$700.00 + GAR from Representative Council account #1391121 to help cover expenses incurred by the UNCED Forum scheduled for July 13.

SECTION 2: A written report and editorials shall be submitted pursuant 36LCB#20.


SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
