ISO (Information Systems Organization) is attempting to attract large and small companies to attend and present at the conference. We are hoping to provide business professionals, students and faculty at CU with an opportunity to exchange and enhance their knowledge about information systems. This conference will also allow close interaction between all attendees, offering an opportunity for faculty, students, and business professionals to network.

Dean Sorenson of the College of Business will introduce our keynote speaker and will be attending the conference. This will provide students, professors and business professionals with the opportunity to meet our new dean.

Through this conference we will enhance the overall image of the University of Colorado by developing greater interaction with the business community and Colorado colleges and universities. This, however, requires funding. Our advertising and operational costs cannot be covered solely with ISO funds. Therefore, we are requesting \$750 of student union funds from UCSU to help us make our conference a success.
