BILL HISTORY

The Journalism Board, the student government of the School of Journalism, is sponsoring a Career Day. Separate from the School of Arts & Sciences Career Day, this focuses, of course, on careers in print news, broadcast, sports writing, advertising, public relations, etc. In previous years, the Journalism Board has compiled various panels with guests from the Denver/Boulder area to focus on the different career paths in Journalism. These panels were kept small and informal to allow for personal interaction between the students and guests. This interaction, and the career and internship contacts developed, are extremely important in such a tight-knit and experience based industry.

This year, the J-Board has been trying to expand their Career Day to include more focused panels, accommodate the increasing number of students, and still keep things on a personal, informal level. Also this year, a major focus on diversity in the field will be addressed by the key-note speaker, Reynelda Muse (a news anchor/reporter for KCNC-TV ch.4) and panelists. Panelists educating our students on Journalism and the diversity in it include Bill Stuart, Bertha Lynn, Kevin Korke, Bonita Robey, Emily Narvaes, Brian Maas, Marsha Neval, Kaylynn Dougall, Sara Norris, David Grimm, Leslie Aaholm, and others.

In past years, the Journalism Board has been able to solely bear the cost of this service. This year, due to the greater size, scope, and functions the budget has expanded dramatically past our means. We hope that you will make this valuable and necessary educational service possible again this year.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill shall allocate \$200.00 + GAR from Council of Colleges and Schools account #1391200 to the Journalism Board to offset costs for their Career Day to be held on April 12, 1993 at the University of Colorado.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges and Schools of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: This bill allocates \$200.00 + GAR from Council of Colleges and Schools account #1391200 to help offset costs in the implementation of the School of Journalism and the Journalism Board's Career Day.

SECTION 2: Any returned funds from previous Council of Colleges and Schools legislation shall go directly to supplement 38CCSB#10 up to \$600.00 plus GAR.

SECTION 3: A report shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.

SECTION 4: This bill takes effect upon passage.
