BILL HISTORY

The student society of the American Society of Civil Engineers is a strong group of dedicated people within the college of engineering. The society provides a means for students to develop the principles of engineering taught in the classroom at a hands on, practical level. The application of concepts taught in the classroom is vital in the students development as a professional engineer. ASCE helps to provide these experiences through various activities.

Every year all of the Universities in the Rocky Mountain Region gather for a conference. This conference provides students with the experiences they are hoping to find. This year the conference is to be held at the Utah State University, April 9 & 10. The objectives of this years conference are to provide the forum for the design and construction of civil engineering related projects. Hands on design experience will be possible through the steel bridge, and concrete canoe competitions. Last year the overall conference title was won by the CU Boulder chapter. It was the first time in recent memory that CU had won the competition. We hope to defend our title at this years conference.

Travel expenses for 24 students are necessary to ensure proper representation and is the reason for this bill. ASCE has solicited additional funding, but not enough to cover costs.

BILL SUMMARY
