BILL HISTORY

The Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers (SHPE) Student Chapter at UC Boulder is an organization that promotes and supports engineering and science education. We act as a support group for over 40 engineering students and regularly tutor students at the junior high and high school level. We also concentrate on developing our members so that they can enter the corporate world effectively. SHPE adds to the diversity of our campus and helps to ensure that students interested in engineering and science will make it to college and make it through college.

The UC Boulder SHPE chapter will be attending a regional meeting over the weekend of October 7-9, 1993 in Albuquerque, New Mexico. SHPE chapter representatives from Utah, Colorado, Kansas and New Mexico will be meeting to discuss regional business and to plan the Region III Leadership conference held at the end of the school year. This meeting is crucial in maintaining communications with other SHPE Chapters in our region and in planning and successful leadership conference. The meeting also offers our chapter a resource of new ideas for community projects, fund-raisers and membership development. Over the October 7-9 weekend, the Region III "Academic Olympiad" will also be held. This Olympiad acts as a play off between students in our region. The regional winners will continue on the national "Academic Olympiad" that will be held at the SHPE National Career Conference in February 1994. The "Academic Olympiad" is a test of students' knowledge in engineering and current events. Overall, the weekend promises to be extremely beneficial to our chapter.

SHPE has decided to take three (3) of our members to this event. The members attending will be the President, the Region III representative, and a representative from the Freshman class. To reduce our costs to attend the event, we have asked for assistance in meals and lodging from the SHPE Chapter in Albuquerque, and they will cover most of these costs. However, we still need funding to cover our transportation costs. Therefore, we request that CCS help to pay for our transportation costs to the event.

SECTION 2: A report shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.


SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
