BILL HISTORY

For the past three years Onstage Student Theater and Dance Group has received monies from a referendum in order to fund visiting guest artists, student projects and performances and meetings to support the campus performing arts community. This funding has been important in helping students enrich their cultural and artistic education and has allowed Onstage to provide free or low cost performances and workshops to all CU students.

Karen Paniservik is an artist who was allocated funding from Onstage for a recent production and paid all costs with out-of-pocket funding, with the understanding from Onstage that she would be fully reimbursed. Because of a misunderstanding, although she is receiving academic credit for the production, it is the responsibility of UCSU to override Student Fee Regulations and remedy the situation.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill overrides Student Fee Regulations to permit Student Organizations Finance Office to reimburse Karen Paniservik for previously incurred expenses related to the Onstage production.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

Section 1:

This bill overrides Student Fee Regulations to permit Student Organizations Finance Office to reimburse Karen Paniservik for previously incurred expenses related to the Onstage production.

Section 2:

It will be understood that upon passage of this measure that persons receiving academic credit will not be able to receive any monies from any UCSU account, per Student Fee Regulations.
