BILL HISTORY

An increasing number of students with children have been enrolling in universities across the nation, including CU-Boulder. These students not only deal with school, but also work, children, families and other activities that can become burdensome. Financial concerns about childcare add to their already existing burden thus withdrawing from their educational goals.

A few years ago the University of Colorado Student Union, with help from the Office of Financial Aid, implemented a childcare scholarship. Funded by student fees, this scholarship has been set up to subsidize daycare expenses for full-time students at CU-Boulder (at least 12 credit hours). Other requirements for qualifications include high financial need, good academic standing (minimum of 2.5), and that the child be in a licensed daycare facility. The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage students with children to pursue their educational goals and lessen their financial burden.
