A BILL

BILL HISTORY

Students have voted against the student athletic fee numerous times. However, many of these questions have been stated in the form of "Do you support the athletic fee?" which unfortunately has been stated by the Regents and other administrators as being a biased question.

Last year after much discussion in a Presidential committee, the Regents voted to decrease the athletic fee by \$7/year and increase the student season football ticket price by \$12/year. Furthermore, they stated that the following year after reviewing the effects on the athletic department budget, there would be another decrease in the fee and another increase in ticket prices. The goal is to decrease the fee to \$50/year and to increase the ticket prices to \$30/year.

This bill will give the students a chance to vote on this important policy issue which directly affects them. Furthermore, this vote would let the Regents and other administrators know the feelings of the students both on the general idea of raising ticket prices and decreasing the athletic fee and on a specific proposal that has been put forth.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill places two referenda questions on the 1993 Fall ballot concerning athletic fee.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Legislative Council shall place the following question on the 1993 Fall Election ballot:

"Are you in favor of a decrease in the athletic fee from \$57/year to \$50/year coupled with an increase in student season football ticket prices from \$22/year to \$30/year?"

SECTION 2: The Legislative Council shall place the following question on the 1993 Fall Election ballot:

"Are you in favor of additional decreases in the athletic fee with additional increases in the student season football ticket price?"
