A BILL

BILL HISTORY

2 The Cooperative Living Group is a student group which has created
a housing cooperative, an affordable and ecologically sound housing
4 alternative. In addition to being a model for others interested in
low impact living, this group provides information on the
6 connection between environmental issues and our daily lives. The
North American Students of Cooperation's (NASCO) Cooperative
8 Education and Training Institute is a workshop series focusing on
skills training for co-op members around the U.S. Training in
democratic management, conflict resolution, creating committees,
10 controlling finances, building relations between co-op and
University, community development, and house officership is offered
12 in the workshops along with courses addressing group dynamics and
race gender issues. Conference educators are professionals in the
14 field of co-op forming and development. Professional training and
personal contacts from the conference will benefit the Cooperative
16 Living Group in its efforts to improve on the Cooperative Housing
model and aid in the creation of other student cooperatives. With
18 cooperative housing, the group seeks to create opportunities for
students to initiate and strengthen student community. As
20 cooperatives are unions of people under a common theme or goal,
students in cooperatives can deal with issues that affect them as
22 an organized group.


